What is Wood Badge? In 1919 Lord Robert Baden-Powell developed and organized a training program for adult leaders that became known as Wood Badge. It is the advanced leadership training for adult leaders in any of the scouting programs. For most Scouter's it's one of the highlights of their scouting careers.

Learn the secrets that all leaders know and use to make leading and team building easy and enjoyable. How? By attending Wood Badge, where these skills will be taught using the latest techniques in a troop setting, using the patrol method of developing leadership and team building skills. The training will be intensive, but **FUN!**

What type of Wood Badge course? This is a full week course that runs for 6 straight days to complete.

Where and when is the course offered?

At Camp John Mensinger, California, Greater Yosemite Council's Sierra Nevada Campground and Scouting Activities Center on **August 1-6, 2011**. This is a week long course.

Who is invited to attend? All adult Scouting leaders for: Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting, Varsity Scouting, and Venturing, including Committee members of all of the above and charter partners, council and district members and council's professional staff. All applicants are subject to the approval of the Council Executive. Participants should have completed "New leader Essentials, and Job Specific Training for their registered position and have completed the Outdoor Skills training".

What is the cost? The cost is \$225 per person, which includes all meals, a participant's neckerchief, and upon completion of your ticket the full Wood Badge regalia consisting of neckerchief, woggle, and beads.

How do I make my reservation to attend? Fill out the reservation form below and mail it into the Greater Yosemite Council office along with a \$50 deposit, this will reserve a place for you on the course.
